

Underlying Principles

Program

Holy Trinity Preschool offers weekday programs for 3, 4 and 5 year-olds under the direction of certified Teachers and Assistants. Class sizes are limited to 12 students.

Traditional teaching methods are coupled with open classroom techniques to give the children experience in self-direction as well as opportunities to function in a structured setting. The program balances classroom activities with special field trips and guests that allow the children to explore and learn about our community and the people in it. Learning experiences appropriate to each age group are incorporated into daily life lessons.

Young learners spend time in play centers conducting activities designed around developmental domains (created by NYS Early Childhood Advisory Council) and that align with NYS Learning Standards.
